On this day, the stage was decorated with an ikebana created by Senshu Ikenobo, the head of the Ikenobo Youth Club (and the son of Senko Ikenobo). The ikebana expresses the beauty of nature, as well as the promise of deepening the connection and trust between Mitsui Ocean Cruises and the people living in the communities MITSUI OCEAN FUJI will visit. The ikebana added to the beauty of Japan of MITSUI OCEAN FUJI's memorable ceremony, which offers "FUNATABI – Beautiful Encounters with Japan."

Sister ship, Nippon Maru, was also in port to greet MITSUI OCEAN FUJI, and guests onboard both ships waved flags, as the ships festively exchanged three horn salutes, symbolizing the "Mitsui" (three bars) motif in the cruise line's brand mark.
